

Martin County Library WiFi Hotspot Policy

The Martin County Library provides mobile WiFi hotspots for checkout to patrons ages 18 and older with a library card in good standing. Failure to follow this policy will result in termination of the borrower's ability to use this service.

Hotspot checkout is limited to one per family. The lending period is one week, and hotspots cannot be renewed or reserved.

The library is not responsible for any liability, damages or expense resulting from the use or misuse of the device, connection of the device to other electronic devices or data loss resulting from the use of the device.

Library hotspots are not filtered. The library is not responsible for information accessed using the device or for personal information that is shared over the Internet. It is prohibited for hotspot users to use the Internet in any way that violates federal, state or municipal laws.

Patrons must present their library card and provide us with an email address to check out the device. Upon check out, the device is the responsibility of the patron. The patron is responsible for any and all costs related to the theft, loss or damage of the device. Devices cannot be returned in the book drop. Please return devices directly to staff at the desk. The replacement cost for the device is \$100. If the device is not returned on time, the device will be remotely deactivated, billed to the patron, and the patron's ability to check-out hotspots will be suspended for 30 days.

If experiencing technical difficulties, return the device to the library.
