We can accept one box of like-new items. Donations are accepted on Monday-Friday from 9 am to 12 pm at the Fairmont Library.

We cannot accept:

Text books

Encyclopedias

Outdated informational items (e.g. technological, tax, investment, medical, educational, legal, etc.)

Reader's Digest abridged or condensed books

Damaged books

Books with water damage or stains

Books that smell like smoke

Books that are grimy, musty, moldy or mildewed

Books with torn pages or covers

Books that are written in

Books with yellowed pages
